

Mathematics Placement Results

Your placement result (overall score) is a number between 0 and 100. It represents the percentage of topics ALEKS has identified you have mastered. Course placement is determined in the table below. There are a few things to note:

- Which course you need to take will depend on your major. You will receive advice on which course you should take during orientation.
- You may also take courses with a score range below your score.
- You may use the ALEKS Prep and Learning Modules (see the “Mathematics Prep and Learning Modules FAQ” for more information) to brush up on topics you may have forgotten or you haven't practiced for some time. You may then re-take the Placement Assessment (up to three times); your highest score will be used for placement.
