

Mathematics Prep and Learning Modules FAQ

After you take the initial Placement Assessment, an individualized Prep and Learning Module will become available. We encourage you to spend time in the Prep and Learning Module regardless of your score on the Placement Assessment. If you do not get your desired score, the Prep and Learning Modules will help you to improve your score, and even if you do get your desired score, time spent in the Prep and Learning modules will lead to better preparation for and potentially improved grades in the math course you take.

How long do I have access to my Prep and Learning Module?

You will have 12 months of access to your Prep and Learning module.

Is there a fee for my Prep and Learning Module?

No, there is no fee for the Prep and Learning Module or for the Placement Assessment.

Must I work in my ALEKS Prep and Learning Module between Placement Assessments?

Yes. You can retake the Placement assessment up to three additional times to improve your score. (The highest score will be used for math placement.) You are required to work in the Prep and Learning Modules for a specific amount of time prior to each Placement Assessment to increase success.

- 2nd Attempt required to complete 5 hours of work in the Prep and Learning Modules before attempting
- 3rd Attempt required to complete 5 (additional) hours of work in the Prep and Learning Modules before attempting
- 4th Attempt required to complete 3 (additional) hours of work in the Prep and Learning Modules before attempting

What are ALEKS Knowledge Checks?

While working in a Prep and Learning Module, you will periodically complete a Knowledge Check to make sure you have mastered the topics you gained in Learning Mode. If you do not show mastery during the Knowledge Check, the topics will be added back into your Learning Pie so you can review them again.
