2023-2024 was a significant year for LTSS in many ways. It was a fruitful academic and fundraising year – and we are grateful for our partnership with donors like you who support our seminarians, their faculty and the programs that prepare leaders for public ministry in today's church.

With your support, more than \$1,418,000 was raised for LTSS last fiscal year. Record Attendance and Support for LTSS Alumni Day

On April 18, 2024, LTSS hosted its fourth annual Day of Giving and the seminary's annual Alumni Day with the event's largest attendance since 2015. Drawing in almost **200 alumni** from around the United States, the community revealed that the deep love of the students and mission is stronger than ever.

The Day of Giving event set another record, exceeding its goal of 100 donors contributing to the seminary in honor of the day with **147 donors giving \$92,055** and breaking the 2023 donation record of \$76,040 from 120 donors.

Many of these gifts were in support of the New Life Fund, the seminary's unrestricted fund which supports every program and every faculty member on campus today. In Fiscal Year 2024, the New Life Fund raised more than \$351,700. From innovative coursework to life-changing internships, from ministry among our seminary community to ministry beyond our campus walls, the moments that define the LTSS experience are shaped each year by your support.
